II. Director Report (Ms. Kois)

There will be makeup assessments for the students that can't be there due to quarantine
- C. Music has been received and Ms. Kois is working on digitizing the music in case we go virtual.
- D. Defer Band is up and running and they are hooked up with smart music that the district provided.
- E. Disney refunds should be sent out starting next week. We were able to get a full refund minus the 4% processing fee. We were the first group to be getting our money back.
- F. Tickets for the football game will have to be purchased and it will be sent out through final forms.
- G. Oct. 14 is a virtual day except for the ones taking the PSAT will have an assignment to complete.
