II. Director Report (Ms. Kois)

- A. Disney Zoom call with Mr. Jack Gray from the tour company to discuss the Disney trip. He explained how Disney suspended all performances and workshop opportunities until the beginning of Oct 1, 2021. Which will be the 50th year Anniversary and there will be special opportunities. He explained that he will work on getting back as much money as possible for us minus the 4% processing fee. He will be reaching out to hotels and his boss regarding possible variation on the hotel refund so parents will know what to expect for a refund. When asked what other schools were doing he informed us that they were canceling all Disney Trips. He said they will be transparent and try and get back as much as possible for everyone. Ms. Kois thanked him for everything and Mr. Gray thanked us and he commended Ms. Kois for all she has done by stepping in like she has.

He will get back with Ms. Kois about the questions. We will need to send an email to the tour company to let them know our decision to cancel the trip. Ms. Kois also informed us after the zoom meeting was over that she had received a message from administration earlier that we would need to cancel the trip for this year as they were not allowing any travel at this time.

B. Game Friday

- a. Ms. Kois has a meeting with Mr. Tevepaugh about a game. She will send out information. We have banners, flyers, and flowers for senior night.
- b. Senior night gifts will be bought by their sections.
- c. When asked if why the "Horse" was not being played, Ms. Kois explained that she had to spread the songs out over the games and it was played at the first game so the plan was to play "September" and because we are limited to how much time we can be on the field and we aren't allowed to do post game. Ms. Kois said maybe next year will be different but we will try and keep the show interesting. A parent did say at this time we just need to be thankful for what we have.

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C. Uniforms

- a. Invoice will need to be paid for a bolt of fabric and a custom jacket and pants and for panels for the jackets and there was overnight shipping. Ms. Kois made the decision to overnight ship or we would not have gotten the panels in time for the game. She offered to cover the shipping since she had made that decision. Sheri G. told Ms. Kois to give her the invoices and she will take care of those with the Band Booster Card. She also informed Ms. Kois she will not need to pay the shipping.
